This is a file to test your AeB Pro installation.

To test the AeB Pro installation, press this button:

Upon pressing the button, if you have installed the `aeb_pro.js` file correctly, a cover page should be inserted as the first page. If the cover page does not appear, check the Acrobat console window **Ctrl+J** for an error message. If you did place `aeb_pro.js` in the use JavaScript folder, and the file was not imported, then either you haven't closed and opened Acrobat after you installed `aeb_pro.js`, or the cover page document `myCoverPage.pdf` does not exist or has been moved from this folder

On failure, did you close Acrobat before opening this file? (The JS files are only read once when the Acrobat application is opened.) When all else fails, try rereading the installation instructions again (`install-jsfiles.pdf`), found in the `doc` folder, but more carefully this time.

Still failing? Do you have Acrobat DC? Perhaps your Acrobat needs to be configured. Try reading `acrobat-in-workflow.pdf`, found in the `doc` folder.
